This year the show will feature “Small Works” and all pieces must be 12 inches and under on all dimensions, including frame.

The exhibition is August 26 – September 23, 2021 with a reception and reunion on Friday, September 10th from 6-8pm. Work will be on view in the VAB Gallery in the Visual Arts Building located on the Carrollton campus.

We are honored to have [Elyse Defoor](#), an artist, curator, and founder of [EBD4 Gallery](#) based in Atlanta serve as Juror for the exhibition. Defoor’s work responds to the wonders and tragedies in this world and her drawings and paintings, sculpture and photography along with her large scale installations have gained international recognition.

Additional activities include the announcement of purchase and merit awards, alumni mentoring talks and other reunion gatherings. We don’t want anyone to miss these events so please stay in touch and share this announcement!

## **RULES OF PARTICIPATION**

### Quantity and Size Limitations

Small Works Exhibition! All UWG alumni are eligible to enter up to 3 pieces of original work completed in the last 5 years. Due to the renovation of the Humanities Building, the exhibition will be held in the VAB Gallery in the Visual Arts Building and all work entered must be no larger than 12" on any side, including frame. **At least one piece from all alumni will be selected for the exhibition.**

### Hanging & Display Requirements

Make sure all artwork is framed and/or otherwise ready to hang and display (hardware on back). Include instructions for wall mounted sculptures or other work with specific installation requirements.

### Insurance

The UWG Department of Art Gallery will assume responsibility for artwork during the exhibition while in the Gallery but does not assume any liability in any other location or in shipment. The artist must be able to provide a third party appraisal for each piece on display to be covered under the UWG insurance program. Otherwise the artist must insure their own work.

### Sales

Work may be priced for sale. The artist will receive 80% of any work sold during the exhibition and a 20% commission will benefit the UWG Department of Art. If work is NFS please make sure to list an insurance value.

### Agreement

The Art Program and gallery committee reserve the right to remove any artwork that is deemed improperly presented, unsafe, damaged, or fails to meet the size limitations and framing or hanging standards.

Participating in this exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the entrant to all conditions set forth in this prospectus. The Art Program reserves the right to reproduce any work in the exhibition for publicity purposes.

- Year Created
- Price/Insurance Value (if work is not for sale label NFS and include insurance value)
